Robert Sidonio Jr, MD, MSc, is a Pediatric Hematologist and Professor of Pediatrics at Emory University School of Medicine. He currently serves as the Medical Director of the Hemophilia of Georgia (HOG) Pediatric Center for Bleeding and Clotting Disorders at Emory.
